CHAIRMAN'S RAMBLINGS

Welcome to our new programme of walks which takes us through the spring and into the summer. At the time of writing restrictions relating to Covid have been eased substantially and group walks should be largely unaffected, though a degree of caution will still be required. The situation, however, may change at very short notice so please check our website or Facebook page before turning up on a walk or alternatively you may wish to contact the walk leader.

On January 29th significant changes were introduced to the Highway Code which give precedence to walkers and cyclists in certain situations, the new code establishing a hierarchy of road users. These changes are generally welcomed by the Ramblers but they have not been widely publicised so walkers would be wise not to rely on motorists either being aware of or adhering to the revised code.

Work on the England Coast Path is now predicted to be completed this year and if achieved will be the culmination of many years work by Natural England, the Ramblers and many other interested bodies. Nearer to home work continues on the Earls Colne to Kelvedon cycle route known as EC2K which should be open to walkers as well. The route has now been extended to Halstead and work has already been carried out clearing the old railway line between Earls Colne and Halstead. When completed the route should provide a welcome connection between the towns and villages of north Essex.

After 9 years on the group's committee, I will be standing down at the end of July so we will be looking for a new chairman and publicity officer. We are also looking for a group secretary and nominations for all these volunteer posts are welcomed. If neither the position of group chairman nor group secretary are filled it is doubtful whether the group can carry on in its present format. It may be possible, with the approval of Essex Area, to convert the group into a Ramblers "Flexigroup" which does not require a committee and imposes less onerous reporting requirements on the group, although a group co-ordinator would be required to organise the walks' programme and act as a point of contact with both Area and Central Office. If none of the key volunteer positions above are filled then it is very likely that the group will have to be closed down or possibly merged with another group. This would be a sad end to a group with nearly 100 members and a 35-year history so I encourage you all to consider standing for one of these positions at our forthcoming EGM in June. If you are unable to attend this EGM you may forward your nomination via email or post to our membership secretary whose details are shown elsewhere in this programme. I look forward to seeing you at our EGM.

THE CENTURY CIRCLE - Section 3

Linear walk, Writtle to Galleywood. Catch No 70 bus from stand 5 at Braintree bus station at 8.25 am to Chelmsford bus station to connect with No 45 bus at 9.30am to Writtle. The walk will start at 10.00 am at the junction of Bridge Street with St John's Green and Lodge Road. Alternatively, park at the free car park in Writtle and catch No 45 bus at the end of the walk to return to one's car. The concluding section is 4.75 miles. No 100 bus can be caught back from Galleywood Common to Chelmsford bus station. However, I am intending to walk back to Chelmsford. This would extend the walk to approximately 8.25 miles.

THE CROUCH VALLEY TRAIL – Section 1

Linear walk Rayleigh to Battlesbridge. Walking via Hockley and Hullbridge. Catch No 70 bus from stand 5 at Braintree bus station at 8.25 am to Chelmsford bus station to connect with No 3 minibus at 9.20 am from stand 1 to Rayleigh. Walk will commence at 10.15 am from bus stop 1 in The Street. At end of walk, catch No 3 minibus from Battlesbridge to Chelmsford. Alternatively, park at the Antiques Centre in Battlesbridge and catch the No 3 minibus at 9.51 am to Rayleigh.

THE CROUCH VALLEY TRAIL – Section 2

Linear walk Battlesbridge to North Fambridge. Walking via Woodham Ferrers, Stow Maries and Cold Norton. Catch No 70 bus from stand 5 at Braintree bus station at 8.25 am to Chelmsford bus station to connect with No 3 minibus at 9.20 am from stand 1 to Battlesbridge. Walk will commence at 10.00 am from Battlesbridge in vicinity of the bridge.

NB: Please inform me if you intending to walk. I have to give at least two days' notice to the minibus company for the journey from North Fambridge to South Woodham Ferrers. At

least 4 people are required in order to provide transport. At end of walk catch No 3 bus from South Woodham Ferrers to Chelmsford.

THE CROUCH VALLEY TRAIL – Section 3

Linear Walk North Fambridge to Burnham on Crouch. Walking on sea wall. Catch No 70 bus from stand 5 at Braintree bus station at 8.25 am to Chelmsford bus station to connect with No 36 bus at 9.20 am to South Woodham Ferrers station. Catch D5 minibus to North Fambridge. This service has to be booked, therefore, **please inform me if you intend to join the walk.** Optional fish and chips on arrival in Burnham on Crouch. It is anticipated that the journey would begin at approximately 10.00 am, so the walk would begin at 10.15 am from North Fambridge station (approximately 5 minutes bus ride). At end of walk catch 31X bus to Chelmsford.

DOVERCOURT WALKS - SUNDAY, 24 JULY

Park at Wick Lane car park or street parking. **Walk 1** – Start 10.00 am at the boating lake. Picnic lunch. Approx 10 miles. **Walk 2** – Start 11.30 am at the boating lake. Easy pace. Picnic lunch. 4-5 miles. Both walks to end at Ann's beach hut for tea and cake.

All walks are circular unless otherwise stated.

It is probably still advisable to take names and contact details for everyone on your walks.

The Ramblers now require a risk assessment to be completed for all group walks for insurance purposes. It is, therefore, advisable to do a "recce" walk and complete assessment.
